

Eagle Bay Post Offices

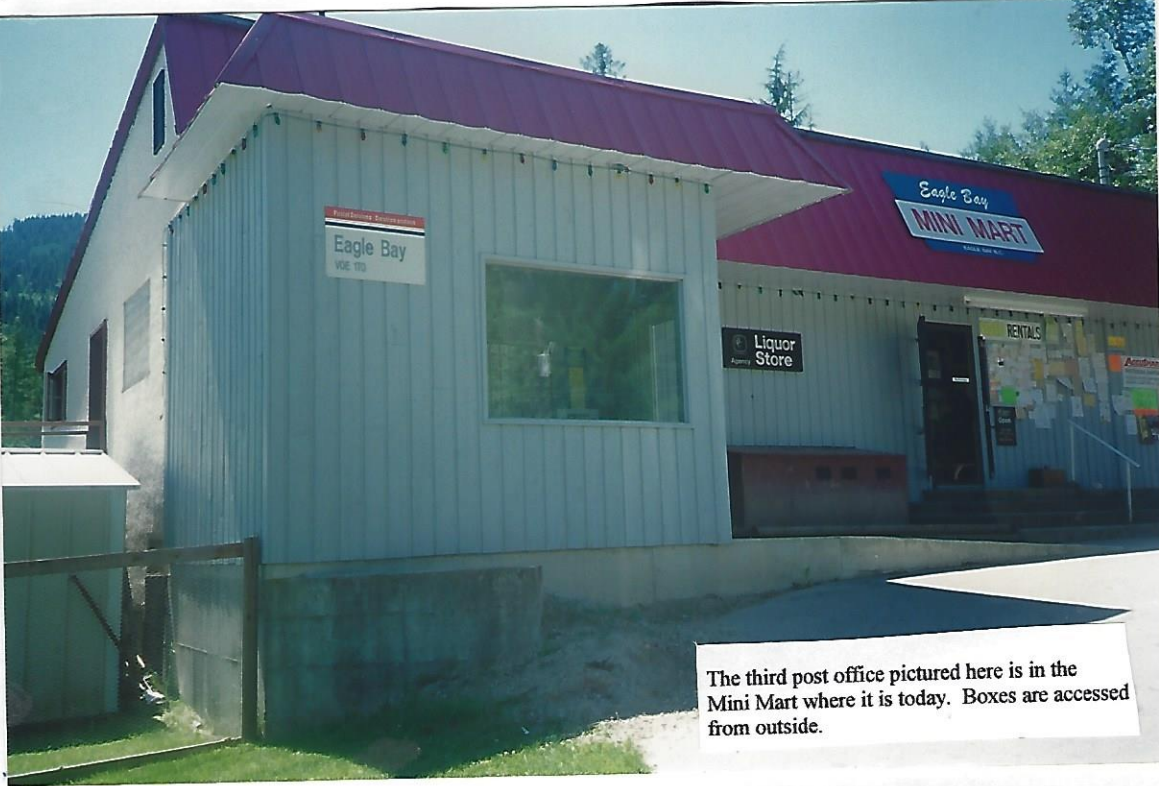


David Lamey
